



Lebanon Township Athletic Association Program Announcement—Field Hockey Is Here!

Lebanon Township Athletic Association (LTAA) is pleased to announce that we will begin offering recreational field hockey for children in Kindergarten through 8th grade this 2017 fall season. LTAA Field Hockey is an instructional program that participates in two leagues:

- NJ/PA Junior Field Hockey League for Kindergarten through 4th grade
- Northwest Jersey Field Hockey Association for 5th through 8th grade¹

These leagues include towns in Warren, Somerset, and Hunterdon Counties in New Jersey and in the Lehigh Valley in Pennsylvania. Regular season games, except for Kindergarten and 1st grades, are played on Sunday afternoons in September and October and will include some travel to participating towns. Preseason practice begins late August and Postseason Tournaments (5–8 only) end early November.

Registration is open now through June 30, 2017 (without late fees) and can be found through the LTAA website (www.ltaanj.org). LTAA accepts players from Califon Borough, Glen Gardner, Hampton Borough, High Bridge Borough, Lebanon Township, and Tewksbury Township (i.e., Voorhees High School sending districts). Our divisions and registration fees are as follows (uniforms included²):
