Nicole Hutzler, President called the meeting to order at 6:33pm.

1) Secretary's Report

- a) Board members reviewed January 5, 2022 minutes. Nikki made a motion to accept January 5, 2022 minutes. Becky seconded. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carries.

2) Treasurer's Report

- a) \$1850 Dean Ramsdell Landscaping – they aerated the field and did the overseeding November 23rd
- b) \$750 to Dean Ramsdell for labor and paint to line the HS field for Gold Ball game
- c) \$135 last application of insecticide
- d) \$173 to Collins Sports for year-end sweatshirt work/additions
- e) Deidra has reached out to Jim Foley for taxes and he will do that. Reports are complete and ready to be processed by Accountant
- f) \$87, 000 in account
- g) 23,000 in equipment fund
- h) Board members reviewed February 2, 2022 treasurer's report. Nikki made a motion to accept February 2, 2022 treasurer's report. Abby Seconded. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carries.

3) SMYFL Updates – Mike not present. Nikki updated us from Mikes notes from SMYFL meeting

- a) They had the annual SMYFL meeting last night (2/1/22). Mike Charbonneau is now the Treasurer.
- b) Lack of officials – league is struggling. Only 16 refs have committed to next year. The only way to get more is for others to get certified. We pay Jr High refs \$125/ game, Pee Wee/Mites \$75/game.
- c) Jamboree is set for Aug. 27 – 28. Potentially Gorham or Noble to host (we are next on the list). Kennebunk and Westbrook are not hosting. This is for Mites and Pee Wee.
- d) Hands off – July 1st – you cannot have coaching level interactions until the 1st official day of practice. Jr. High start – Aug. 8, Aug. 15 for all others. Flag to start once school starts.

4) Program Updates

- b) **Peewee Football:** Nate LaPierre
 - i) Recruiting all aspects. Nicole Bothwell is interested in Coordinator.
- c) **Junior High Cheer:** Alexis Bourque not present, no updates.

 - iv) Wee Cheer Grades 1-2 (more skills), Mites(3/4), Pee Wee(5/6), Jr. High (7/8th)
 - v) Beth – will help coach any grade level
 - vi) Kim would like to nominate **Beth Huri** as Pee Wee Cheer Coach. Options for additional questions (there were none). Becky seconded. All in favor, no one opposed. Motion carries. *Congratulations Beth!*
- e) **Mighty Mite Football:** Jason Moody
 - i) All assistant coaches locked down.
 - ii) March/April is when we typically nominate
- f) Flag Football: Tom Protasewich
 - i) In need of a Kindergarten coach

5) Old Business:

- a) Bylaws/Articles of Incorporation Discussion
 - i) Make a motion to table until Mike is back. Becky seconded. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carries.
- b) Look at equipment and inventory needs (google doc) and how to allocate \$ (some examples below)
 - i) Lights at Fronco Field (Electrical work and quote needed so we can get approved (Lights on poles, getting rid of generators, light on building. Jon to get quote)
 - ii) Pants and shoulder pads – Mike did you reach out to Riddell rep?
 - iii) Practice jersey's (Mites – Jr. High)
 - iv) Rogers athletic sled needs pads
 - v) Make a motion to table until March agenda. Jason seconded. All in favor, none opposed. Motion carries.
- c) Any interest in Mites Cheer coordinator, Pee Wee Football Coordinator, Junior High Cheer Coordinator or Pee Wee Cheer Coordinator?
 - i) Mites Cheer Coordinator – Kim would like to nominate Rachel Protasewich as coordinator for Mites Cheer Coordinator. Options for additional questions (there were none). Becky seconded. All in favor. No one opposed. Motion carries. *Congratulations, Rachel!*

6) New Business

- a) Increasing articles of incorporation – table until March until Mike is present under old business
- b) Update from Football Summer camp rep
 - i) Football camp – Jason Jackson. Started in Cape. Was an assistant coach at Cape middle/high school. Head football coach at Deering. 6th and 8th in Cape. Started as a fundraiser. Grid Iron Hustle Camp.
 - ii) Recruits older kids as coaches. Gives them the following: \$20/day (all five day =\$100). And also 40 volunteer hours. And letter of recommendation for college. Food included all week for coaches.
 - iii) \$180/kid. T shirts at the end of the week.

- iv) Mon-Thurs 9am – 4pm. Friday is a half day until 12, playoff/championship Friday
- v) Stations during the day. Non-contact camp. Play games all day. They have a draft for the kids.
- vi) Age group – NCAA division - 3rd, 4th, 5th. NFL division - 6th, 7th, 8th/
- vii) Equipment – Sunscreen, water, cleats, sneakers, slides and lunch
- viii) Would like to use High School Field or our practice fields at Fronco.
- ix) Portland and Freeport date set in stone
- x) Potentially have in Wells week of July 11th
- xi) 7-8 kids per team and 2 coaches per team
- xii) No more than 70 per division
- xiii) Grid Iron Hustle camp would handle all registration. We would provide kid coaches and some football supplies.
